### ART DÜSSELDORF announces list of exhibitors for its first edition

ART DÜSSELDORF announces their exhibitor list joining the 2017 premiere edition of the fair, which will run 17 – 19 November 2017 (preview and opening day: 16 November) at the Areal Böhler. Modern and contemporary art will be shown by 80 established and young galleries coming from over 21 different countries. Of the participating galleries, 60% come from the region (from Germany and from Benelux) with the remaining 40% consisting of international galleries from countries including the USA, Portugal, Japan, Taiwan and Israel.
